## Examiner Panel

**Terms of Reference:** To assess candidates at NQEMT examinations.

**Membership:** Appointed by Director (Ref: DAT003).

1. Must be nominated by a medical, nursing or training representative body; CPG approved pre-hospital emergency care service provider or recognised institution.
2. Must be a registered medical practitioner, a registered nurse or on the PHECC Register for a minimum of 3 years. If a doctor, he/she must be at least Registrar level, it is desirable to hold a postgraduate qualification.
3. Must satisfy two or more of the following criteria:
  - Liaise with pre-hospital emergency care practitioners at a professional level in everyday practice
  - Involved in education of medical, nursing or pre-hospital emergency care practitioners
  - Previous evidence of participation in pre-hospital emergency care practitioner matters
  - Involved in delivery of acute care
  - Advanced life support instructors.
4. Must successfully complete PHECC examiner training and refresher workshops as deemed necessary.
5. May participate in NQEMT examinations at and below their level of registration.
