### **PHECC EXAM TEAM WISH TO ASSURE YOU THAT AS ALWAYS WE ARE AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE ANY GUIDANCE ON RELATED MATTERS DURING THE CURRENT COVID-19 SITUATION**

#### **Prometric Test Centres:**

Most Prometric Test Centres are currently operating.

All NQEMT candidates, who have received their eligibility numbers from PHECC, can continue to book and take their MCQ exam. However, if the centre you have selected closes, Prometric will contact you and facilitate you with an alternate test centre of your choice. Prometric Test Centers have followed the advice and guidelines outline by HSE and added additional precautions in test centres including but not limited to:

- Increased social distancing levels in waiting areas
- Ensuring minimum social distancing guidelines between candidates when testing
- Sanitisation of all workstations between candidates
- Hand washing facilities are available in all test centres
- Hand gel available in test centres where stock remains available
- Candidates can wear masks during testing
- Candidates can wear gloves during testing
- HSE information posters are on display in all test centres.

#### **May 2020 EMT OSCEs;**

Currently May 2020 OSCEs are scheduled to take place as planned. However, we are in uncertain times and there may be a COVID-19 requirement to reschedule. If this does arise we will be in touch with you in advance.

#### **6-month exam completion rule:**

If due to COVID-19 you are applying for your NQEMT EMT exam or taking your exam outside the six-month rule period, we will endeavour to accommodate you without forfeiting an exam attempt.

#### **Exam Viewing sessions:**

Viewing sessions will be facilitated as normal. Be reassured that HSE Social Distancing guidelines will be in place and hand sanitisers are available as follows:

- i) At Beech House entrance
- ii) On exit from lift at PHECC office
- iii) In the Viewing Room
