Prometric Test Centres:

In line with the Government's recommendation in order to limit the spread of COVID-19, Prometric Test Centres globally, including Ireland have now closed.

Prometric test centres were due to open in May but due to the extension of Government restrictions this has now changed and Prometric Test Centres plan to open after 8th June unless otherwise advised by the Government.

However, your application is being processed in the normal way and your MCQ will be scheduled when the test centres re-open after the 8th of June 2020.

On receipt of your Eligibility email please **DO NOT LOG ONTO THE PROMETRIC SITE TO BOOK YOUR TEST**. We will contact you to schedule your exam.

Rescheduled - May 2020 EMT OSCEs

The EMT OSCEs which were previously scheduled for the 26th and 27th of May have been deferred to the end of July.

The Department of Health have noted the social distancing issues which would arise if the OSCE went ahead due to it being a practical examination of competencies which involves the exam candidate, simulated patient, PHECC examiner and PHECC exam quality person in a small space at the same time.

PHECC are working to reschedule these exams at the end of July (subject to Government Restrictions and HSE Guidelines) and we will be in touch as soon as we have further information.

6-month exam completion rule:

If due to COVID-19 you are applying for your NQEMT EMT exam or taking your exam outside the six-month rule period, we will endeavour to accommodate you without forfeiting an exam attempt.

Exam Viewing sessions:

PHECC will facilitate your Exam Viewing when the COVID-19 restrictions are relaxed by the Government and expect to advise you after 18th of May.

PHECC will continue to accept Viewing Applications that we receive.
